



7 Yaks Design

Baby Booties



Directions:

With A, cast on 26 stitches. Work 3 rows in garter stitch.

Join B, cut A.

Work 3 rows in garter stitch, then work eyelet row as follows:

*k2, yo, k2 together, rep from * to end, k2.

Work 5 rows garter.

Knit 9 stitches, please these on a stitch holder. Knit next 8 stitches, place remaining 9 stitches on a holder. Working on the center 8 stitches only, knit 8 more rows. Cut yarn. Now slip all stitches on one needle.

Beginning at the start of the row, rejoin yarn and knit 9 stitches, pick up 9 stitches across the side of center section, pick up 9 stitches down the other side of the center section, knit last 9 stitches = 44 stitches.

Gauge:
About
5.5 sts/inch

MATERIALS:

- A = 2 - 3 yds novelty yarn
- B, C, D = light worsted or DK weight yarn
- Approximately 2 yds fancy ribbon
- Size 3 needles
- Row Counter (optional)
- Stitch marker
- Stitch holders
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors

Purl back 1 row. Cut yarn.

Change to color C. Work in garter stitch for 15 rows.

Shape welt:

Slip the first stitch to the right needle. Now with the tip of right needle, dip down 3 rows and lift this stitch to the left needle. Knit this stitch. Pass the slipped stitch over this knitted stitch and repeat this process until all stitches are used = 44 stitches.

Knit 1 row, placing marker after 22 stitches. There should be 22 stitches on either side of marker. Cut yarn.

Change to Color D.

Row 1: Knit 2 stitches together, k to last 3 stitches (slipping marker at center), k2 together, k 1 stitch.

Row 2: Knit to within 2 stitches of marker, k 2 together, slip marker, k 2 together, k to end of row.

Repeat these 2 rows 3 more times.

Bind off all stitches.

Sew bottom and back seam. Weave in all ends.

Thread ribbon through eyelet row and tie in a bow.
